# Royalty of Rock 'n Roll All-Stars

The Royalty of Rock 'n Roll All-Stars are a nationally known "oldies but goodies" group that calls Boston home base. The All-Stars have performed on the Norwegian Majesty cruise ship from Boston to Bermuda annually since 1995 and also at Foxwoods Casino and Resort. They have performed their high energy review of the greatest songs of the 1950's and 60's music at venues throughout New England including, Mt. Washington Resort, NH; Ogunquit Playhouse and Merrill Auditorium in Portland, Maine; Rochester Opera House and Colonial Theater in Keene, New Hampshire, Providence Performing Arts Center, Providence Rhode Island; the Palace Theatre in Waterbury, Connecticut, and Symphony Hall in Boston.

Harvey Robbins, leader of the Royalty of Rock 'n Roll All-Stars, is founder and president of the Doo-Wopp Hall of Fame of America© which annually honors original artists from the 1950's and early 1960's at Symphony Hall in Boston. Harvey is an original member of Boston's Interludes and has produced concerts since 1986, featuring Tom Jones, Wayne Newton, Dionne Warwick, Roy Orbison, Hank Ballard, and many of the great Doo-Wopp artists from the golden age of Rock 'n Roll. He previously was an award-winning journalist covering the Boston Celtics for 10 years, and earned the Audubon A Award for his lead role in the effort to save historic Prowse Farm from industrial encroachment. His book "Betrayal" played a major role in the 1988 presidential election. He continues today as President of the non-profit "Friends of Prowse Farm" which sustains Prowse Farm in Canton, Massachusetts..
